## Popular methods used in measuring SH engagement,



#### **Surveys and Interviews:**

Feedback through surveys and interviews on involvement, satisfaction, and impact.



#### **Participation Rates:**

Tracking participation rates in meetings, workshops, and projects



#### **Behavioural Indicators:**

Observing changes in stakeholder behaviour like support and adoption of practices



#### **Outcome Evaluation:**

Evaluating outcomes such as improved conservation, reduced conflicts, and community well-being

### **Basic tools for SH analysis**



#### Mapping:

Identify key stakeholders, their interests, influence, and contributions to goals.



### Surveys:

Gather feedback on opinions, preferences, and priorities



**Conflict Resolution:** Use negotiation, mediation, and consensus-building.



### **Network Analysis:** Examine relationships and communication dynamics
